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Expanding Access to Early Childhood Programs

The Application for Access to Early Childhood Development Programs and Services (the application) is completed in collaboration with the child's parent/carer, and relevant members of the education team, and submitted to the regional office for approval of the child's registration in an early childhood development program and/or service.

The department provides early childhood development programs (ECDPs) and services to support children aged 0-5 years with significant educational support needs arising from a diagnosed or suspected disability in the categories of autism spectrum disorder (ASD), hearing impairment, intellectual disability, physical impairment, speech-language impairment and vision impairment.

The results consistently show program effectiveness and the economic value of providing disadvantaged children with access to quality early childhood programs. Programs work for the disadvantaged. Heckman finds that effectiveness depends on program quality, the characteristics of those being served and their access to alternative programs.

Early Childhood Education: Quality and Access Pay Off ...

Since higher income children are currently more likely to have access to high-quality early education, expanding access to all would narrow the achievement. Early childhood education can boost children's earnings later in Long-term analyses suggest that early childhood education can increase earnings in adulthood by 1.3 to 3.5 percent.
