From the desktop, left-click on the File Explorer icon on the Taskbar or press the Windows logo key + E. Navigate to C:\Users\ your user name \ Right-click the folder that you previously redirected and want to restore to its original location, and then click Properties. Click the Location tab, click Restore Default, and then click OK.
